So who are the Friends of Kingscote (FoK)?

The “Friends of Kingscote” (FoK) was established over 30 years ago. The main purpose of the group is to maintain Kingscote Station as it would have been in the 1950’s British Rail era.

At present we have just under 140 supporters who subscribe on a yearly basis. The funds generated are used for various projects and maintenance which is undertaken by our volunteers. We have a nucleus of 16 volunteer FoK workers who usually meet on Tuesdays and Saturdays. An annual Newsletter is produced which is sent to all our subscribers in August.

Kingscote Station was part of the London, Brighton and South Coast Railway from August 1882 to 31st December 1922, after which it became part of the Southern Railway and then British Railways in 1948. In its early years the station won awards for floral displays; a tradition we still try to maintain. It finally closed for passenger traffic in May 1955. In 1964 Kingscote Station was sold and became the property of a private purchaser thus ensuring that at least the station house was preserved.

It was re-purchased by the Bluebell Railway in 1985. The “Friends of Kingscote” subsequently formed and set about the huge challenge of renovating the station over the next 9 years. The first passenger train arrived at Kingscote on 23rd April 1994. The station was the northern terminus of the Bluebell Railway for 19 years until in March 2013 the line re-opened to East Grinstead. The station then returned to a quiet existence much as it would have been in the late 1950s.

FoK Working Volunteers

The “Friends of Kingscote” is always looking to recruit new working volunteers. If you wish to visit and see what we do, Tuesday and Saturday mornings between 9 am and 10 am are a good opportunity. Or if you happen to visit the station and see one of us at work please stop and have a chat. To be a working member you will have to belong to the Bluebell Railway and join the FoK.
