Kingscote Station Heritage Trail:

The Kingscote Heritage Trail (K H T) is a simple trail consisting of 16 locations to help guide you around Kingscote Station. Each of these locations is marked by a black on light grey numbered trail plate. Each plate also contains a specific QR code which directs the reader to the trail page on the Bluebell Railway website. This will display the relevant information for that locality and in some cases has links to other Bluebell Railway information. You can also find the heritage trail by the link from Kingscote Station on the website.

The trail does follow a route around the station but feel free to tackle it in any order. There are 2 types of quiz linked to the trail. One is aimed at the family with children up to the age of about 8 and the second for the 9-13 year old, or indeed anyone else who is interested. If there are none available at the start point, Trail Plate KHT 1, then please call in at the Booking Hall if it is staffed, on your way to location KHT 2 and ask for one there.
