

British Railways designed Standard 5 'Camelot'. Built in 1955 for use on both passenger and goods trains. Camelot will be pulling set B on Saturday and Sunday



British Railways designed Standard Class 4MT. Built in 1956 at Brighton Works for mixed traffic work. 80151 is the youngest of this class to be preserved and spent its working life on the Southern Region. 80151 will be pulling set A on Saturday, Sunday



London Brighton & South Coast Railway designed, Class A1 'Fenchurch'. Built the light-weight suburban trains on the South London line. Capable of rapid acceleration, the Terriers were ideal for this line, where the stations were often only a mile apart.
